ASGARD group reinforces its Metrology and Maintenance activities

The ASGARD group is pursuing its acquisition strategy by closing on January 31, 2018, the acquisition of SEMELEC through SOFIMAE, its wholly-owned subsidiary.

Since 1972, SEMELEC has been providing metrology and maintenance services on customer sites or from its laboratory in Les Ulis (91), south of Paris. SEMELEC offers a multi-brand service offer that is independent of the manufacturers. SEMELEC provides its customers with recognised know-how and expertise in industrial metrology, in the fields of Electricity-Magnetism, Time-Frequency, Temperature, Mass, Forces and Pressure.

Thanks to the quality of its services, SEMELEC has won the trust of a large number of customers present in all industrial sectors such as aeronautics / space, defense, telecoms, rail, automotive, electronics, energy and the medical. SEMELEC's laboratories in the fields of Electricity-Magnetism and Time-Frequency are accredited by COFRAC. In these same fields, SEMELEC also has a COFRAC accreditation for services performed on the customer site.

SOFIMAE has been offering for the last forty years a complete range of verification, calibration, maintenance and fleet management services carried out on site and in its laboratories based in Ris-Orangis (91). SOFIMAE acts in many fields of activity and has developed a customer base in several sectors: energy, automobile, nuclear, defense, transport and telecom. SOFIMAE has three COFRAC accreditations: Temperature, Time - Frequency and Electricity - Magnetism.

SOFIMAE achieved in 2017 a turnover of 1.6 M €.

Bringing together the services, skills and resources of SOFIMAE and SEMELEC will enable the ASGARD Group to strengthen its offering of Metrology services, and thus improve its response to customer relations and expectations. Since the sale in 2016 of its electronic manufacturing activities carried out by ALLIANSYS, the ASGARD Group has combined three companies in the Instrumentation business: AOIP, DIMELCO and SOFIMAE now associated with SEMELEC. AOIP is a recognised player in Measurement domain, whose equipment and solutions are used by more than 40,000 customers in some 60 countries covering all sectors of industry and laboratories. DIMELCO is a specialised distributor present throughout France, offering multi-brand measuring equipment for industrial use and instrumentation solutions. In addition to selling equipment, DIMELCO offers metrology, verification and maintenance services to its customers.

AOIP and DIMELCO are respectively based in Ris-Orangis (91), south of Paris area, and Fretin (59), close to Lille.
